Preparation of Demand Statement Recovery of instalments of purchase priceas arrears of land revenue - regarding.

Memorandum:

The undersigned presents compliments to the Commissioner Bombay Division and with reference to the corrospondence resting with his letter No.TNC.930 dated 15th October,1968 on the above subject is directed to state that the point referred to Government is whether the entire purchase price including the instalments becoming due in future should be treated as the amount recoverable as arrears of land revenue. Section 32K(5) of the Bombay Tenancy and Agricultural Lands Act,1948 reads as follows:

i) If a tenant-purchaser fails to pay the entire amount of the purchase price within the period fixed under the provisions of this section or is in arrears of four instalments where the number of instalments fixed is four or more, and all the instalments in any other case, the amount of the purchase price remaining unpaid and the amount of interest thereon at the rate of 4½ per cent.per annumm, if any, shall be recoverable by the Tribunal as an arrear of land revenue.

The word the amount of operchase price remaining unpaided and used in section 32-K(3) would obviously include only the amount (the instalments) which has become due for payment but has remained un-paid.

In view of this legal position the Commissioner is requested to issue necessary instructions to the revenue officers accordingly in the matter.


